

SIZES: Socks are sized to fit Adult Small (Medium, Large, X-Large).

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Foot Length: 9 (9½, 10½, 11)"

MATERIALS

1, 150 g ball **Schachenmayr original Regia 6-ply Stripemania Color** color #06368 Fire.

Size 6 US (4 mm) 16" (40 cm) circular needle.

Set of 4, Size 6 US (4 mm) double-pointed needles.

Size D/3 (3.25 mm) crochet hook.

6, ½" (14 mm) diameter non-sew press-on fasteners. **Optional:** 1 pair of leather slipper soles in desired size Yarn needle, stitch marker, stitch holder

GAUGE: 22 sts x 30 rows/rnds = 4" [10 cm] in Stockinette st

DESIGNER NOTES

If exact color matching for each sock is desired, unwind yarn for second sock to reach color of yarn in order to match color repeat at beg of first sock. Always pull the yarn from the outside of the ball.

STITCH GLOSSARY

Beg beginning/begin

circ circular CO cast on

dpn(s) double-pointed needle(s)

est establish

Klb insert RH ndl through center of st in row

below and knit a new st; drop original st

from LH ndl. **kwise** knit wise

LH left hand ndl needle

PM (pm) place marker RH right hand

RS right side RSR right side row



skp slip 1 st, knit 1 st, pass the slipped st

over the knit st

sl slip

St st Stockinette st st(s) stitch(es)

tog together
WS wrong side

WSR wrong side row
wyif with yarn in front

wyib with yarn in back

STITCH PATTERNS

Stockinette st in the rnd: k every rnd.

Brioche Pattern (over an odd number of sts)
In rows:

Row 1 (WS): PI (selvage st), *kl, pl; rep from * to last 2 sts; kl, pl (selvage st).

Row 2 (RS): K1 (selvage st), *p1, k1b; rep from *

to last 2 sts; pl, kl (selvage st). Repeat Rows 1–2 for Brioche patt.

In rounds:

Rnd 1: *pl, kl; rep from * to last st; pl. Rnd 2: *pl, klb; rep from * to last st; pl. Repeat Rnds 1-2 for Brioche patt.

w&t (wrap and turn)

Knit side: Wyib, slip next st pwise. Move yarn between the ndls to the front. Slip the same st back to the LH ndl. Turn work, bring yarn to the purl side between needles. One st is now

wrapped. When short rows have been completed, work to just before the wrapped st, insert RH ndl under the wrap and kwise, into the wrapped st, knit these two sts too.

Purl side: Wyif, slip next st pwise. Move yarn between the ndls to the front. Slip the same st back to the LH ndl. Turn work, bring yarn to the purl side between needles. One st is now wrapped. When short rows have been completed, work to just before the wrapped st, insert RH ndl under the wrap and kwise, into the wrapped st, purl these two sts tog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cuff is worked first, back and forth in rows then folded in half; live sts are then joined to cast-on sts to form a tube which becomes the leg portion of the sock. Stitches for the foot are then picked up around the bottom edge of the cuff.

LEFT SOCK

Cuff

With circ ndl, CO 47 sts and beg Brioche patt Row 1. Cont working in patt back and forth in rows until piece meas 834" from CO, after after a WSR.

Next row (RS): Fold work in half with WS tog and with RH ndl, pick up first CO st and place it on the LH ndl; k2tog (CO st with next st on LH ndl). *With RH ndl, pick up next CO st and place it on LH ndl, k2tog (CO st with next st on LH ndl), then pass first st on RH ndl over second st to BO. Rep from * until a total of 18 sts have been joined and bound-off in this manner (29 sts rem for overlap flap). Working back and forth in rows, cont in Brioche patt on rem 29 flap sts for 1½", end after WSR.

Next row (RS): BD all sts kwise. Cut yarn and fasten off.

Leg

With RS facing and dpns, evenly pick up and k47 sts along outside row ends of cuff (see photo as a guide). Distribute sts evenly on 3 ndls (Ndl 1: 12 sts; Ndl 2: 23 sts; Ndl 3: 12 sts] making sure cuff seam is positioned at outside of foot, between Ndl 1 and Ndl 2. Join to work in the round and PM to indicate beg of rnd.

Establish Pattern

Work sts on Ndl 1 and Ndl 3 in St st in the rnd (k every rnd) [24 sts]; work 23 sts on Ndl 2 in Brioche patt. Work in patt as est for 4 rnds, end after working sts on Ndl 2.

Heel (Short Rows)

Leaving sts on Ndl 2 unworked, shape heel as foll:

Row 1 (RS): Beg on Ndl 3, K12 sts, then K11 sts from NdII: w&t.

Row 2 (WS): PII sts from NdII, PII sts from NdI 3. w&t.

Row 3: K71 sts. wfit.

Row 4: P20 sts. w8t.

Row 5: K19 sts. w&t.

Row 6: PIR sts. wfit.

Row 7: K17 sts. w&t.

Row 8: PIR sts. wRt.

Row 9: KI5 sts. wSt.

Row 10: P14 sts. w&t.

Row 11: KI3 sts. wSt. Row 12: P17 sts. wfit. Row 13: KII sts. w&t.

Foot Next row: KI6 sts from Ndl 1, patt across 23 sts, K8 sts onto Ndl 3. Divide sts evenly between Ndl 1 and 3 [12 sts each]. Cont in St st (k every rnd) on Ndls 1 and 3 and Brioche patton Ndl 2 until piece meas 7½ (8,9,9½)" from the end of heel shaping or approx. 1/2" shorter than the desired foot length, ending after working

Toe

sts on Ndl 3.

Cont in St st on all sts.

Row 14: PID sts. wSt.

Row 15: K9 sts. w&t.

Row 16: PR sts wht

Rnd 1: K across Ndl 1 sts to last 3 sts; k2tog, k1; on Ndl 2, kl, skp, k8, make 1 st, k to last 3 sts; k2tog, kl; on Ndl 3, k1, skp, knit to end of ndl..

Rnd 2: Knit. Rep last two rnds 3 more times, then rep Rnd 1 until a total of 16 sts rem. Knit sts from NId 3 onto Ndl 1 (8 sts on each ndl). Graft end of toe using varn needle and Kitchener stitch.

RIGHT SOCK

Work as given for Left Sock, reversing cuff and overlap when piece meas 83/4" from CO, end after a WSR.

Next row (RS): Work first 29 sts in Brioche patt, place rem 18 sts on a stitch holder. Cont on rem 29 sts in Brioche sts for 1½" (overlap flap), end after a WSR. Next row (RS): BD all sts kwise. Cut yarn and fasten off. Move sts from stitch holder to dpns, ready to work a RSR. Join new yarn end and join/

bind off rem 18 sts to their corresponding CO sts as aiven for Left Sock.

Foot

With RS facing and dpns, evenly pick up and k47 sts along outside row ends of cuff (see photo as a quide). Distribute sts evenly on 3 ndls [Ndl 1: 12 sts; Ndl 2: 23 sts; Ndl 3: 12 sts] making sure cuff seam is positioned at outside of foot, between Ndl 2 and Ndl



3. Join to work in the round and PM to indicate beg of rnd. Work remainder of Right Sock as given for Left Sock.

FINISHING

With crochet hook, work around the top edge of the leather soles (before attaching to socks) as foll: join yarn with a sl st to first pre-punched hole; ch 1, work 2 sc in first pre-punched hole, ch 1, *work 2 sc in next pre-punched hole, ch 1; rep from * around. SI st to first sc, cut yarn and fasten off. With yarn needle, weave in all ends. Sew socks to slipper soles along crocheted edge. Attach non-sew press-on fasteners to overlap and cuff, following manufacturer's instructions.
